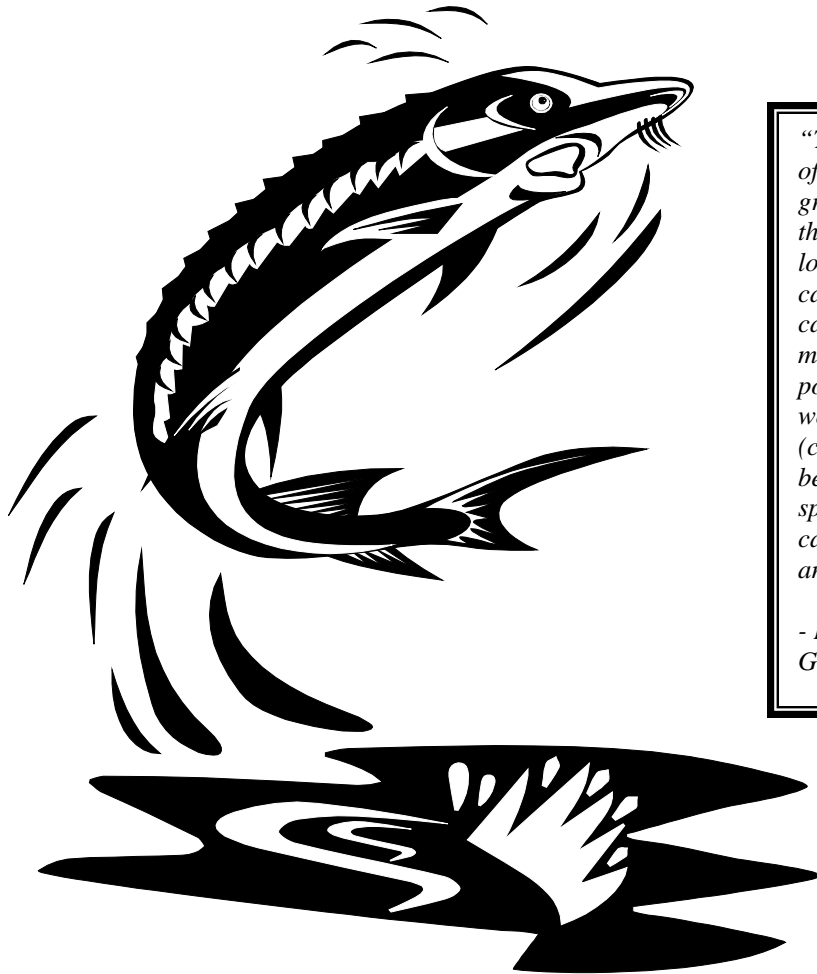


EARTH DAY, EarthVigil
