

The Rochester People's Climate Coalition (RPCC) is an inclusive, non-partisan network of organizations unified by our determination to identify and implement effective climate solutions. RPCC's membership includes businesses, faith, civic, labor, and environmental groups.

RPCC brings together well-informed stakeholders to develop strategies that will quickly and effectively reduce emissions from locally significant sources. We educate the public about our initiatives through direct outreach and media campaigns, and then mobilize them for targeted actions. One of the most powerful resources provided by RPCC is the opportunity to collaborate with other organizations invested in climate action. This happens at our Collaboration Team meetings, member events and trainings, and our online communication platform (Slack), exclusively intended to facilitate direct cross-member collaboration.

RPCC membership benefits include...

- Assistance in moving your organization towards environmental sustainability through annual one-on-one coaching to help your organization develop an internal plan for how to prioritize and implement sustainability measures, take advantage of the financial benefits of environmental sustainability (e.g., revenue opportunities and cost reductions), and assess progress toward achieving these goals.
- Movement-building training for activating change-makers (e.g. community organizing, lobbying, communication strategies, etc.).
- Invitation to member-only networking events, including pre-event member-only receptions.
- Access to online platform where members can communicate directly with each other.
- Individuals within member organization are also invited to participate in RPCC's Action Pathway Teams, Collaboration Team, Board committees, and short-term task forces, according to their skills, interests, and availability.
